## **P(UK) 2010 POLLYANNA CHAMPIONSHIPS**

The first three competitors (horse/pony/rider/handler) in each class will qualify, once qualified if the rider/handler is not a current P(UK) Annual Member or P(UK) Riders Club Member they then have 14 days to submit their membership for the qualification to remain valid. The exception being any competitor qualifying at a show between 1<sup>st</sup> July and 31<sup>st</sup> July must submit their membership within 48 hours after the qualifying event in order for the qualification to remain valid.

# P(UK) 2010 SUMMER NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

## Qualification for Summer National Championships

**1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placed ponies/horses in all Summer National Championships will qualify for the 2010 P(UK) Summer National Championships.**

Results must be submitted to the Ponies (UK) offices within 14 days of the qualifying show with the exception of shows being held between 1<sup>st</sup> July and 31<sup>st</sup> July need to submit their results within 48 hours after the qualifying event.

Competitors in qualifying positions, who are **not** current members of P(UK) are allowed **14 days** in which to become members and register their horses/ponies in order for the qualification to remain valid. The exception being any competitor qualifying at a show between 1<sup>st</sup> July and 31<sup>st</sup> July must submit their membership within 48 hours after the qualifying event in order for the qualification to remain valid.

A copy of the final schedule stating Judges appointed must be forwarded 2 months before the date of the event

Affiliation will **NOT** be accepted until:

- The Affiliation form and fee has been received, after which an affiliation number will be allocated.
- A draft schedule, which **must** include the Judge's names, together with a copy of the current Public Liability Policy must be sent to P (UK).
- The Final Schedule **MUST** not be printed or issued until the draft has been approved and all amendments requested by P (UK) have been incorporated into the Final Schedule.
- Affiliations will be withdrawn if qualifying events fail to send in an approved final schedule and valid insurance certificate at least eight weeks prior to the event

**A CHANGE OF SHOW SECRETARY MUST BE NOTIFIED TO THE P (UK) OFFICE IMMEDIATELY in order that the Website can be updated.**

## SHOWS AFFILIATED TO P (UK) WITH WEBSITES

**PLEASE ENSURE YOU SUPPLY US WITH YOUR CURRENT WEBSITE ADDRESS IN ORDER FOR US TO PROVIDE A LINK FOR COMPETITORS TO VISIT YOUR SHOWS WEBSITE AND DOWNLOAD SCHEDULES ETC AS REQUIRED TO PROMOTE YOUR EVENT**

## JUDGES TRAVELLING FEES / EXPENSES

Shows are expected to pay Judges reasonable travelling fees or any other expenses; we advise a maximum amount to be agreed **prior** to the event, preferably in writing. If Officials are expected to work on a voluntary basis this should be agreed prior to the date of the show.

## RIDE JUDGES

Shows affiliated to P (UK) - who are not affiliated to an individual Governing Body - may select to omit the Ride Judge from any Horse classes providing an R-Con Judge is used. Should a Ride Judge fall or be thrown whilst judging under P (UK) rules they may not continue to ride the exhibits or carry out any further ride judging on that day. If the Judge is capable of continuing his/her duties then all exhibits in the class must give an individual show (including any exhibit previously ridden). In the event that the Judge is not capable of continuing, an appropriately qualified replacement may be appointed otherwise the class must be abandoned. Should a replacement Judge be appointed or the class abandoned a full report must be submitted in writing to P (UK) within 7 days of the incident.

ALL Ride Judges officiating under Ponies Association (UK) rules **MUST** wear a hat to the approved current BSI standard at all times whilst mounted.

## WHP CLASSES

WHP & M&M WHP Judges may judge the jumping phase (phase 1) of any WHP class.

## ***NORTHERN & SOUTHERN WINTER NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS Including AMATEUR RIDERS CHAMPIONSHIPS***

- ◆ **1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>** placed horses/ponies **in each** Ponies Association (UK) Winter National Championship Qualifying class will qualify. Qualification will pass **no lower than 3<sup>rd</sup> place**
- ◆ Qualification is **open to Members & Non-Members** of Ponies Association (UK)
- ◆ Once qualified if the owner is not a current “A” member, the rider/handler is not a current “A” or Junior/Senior riders club member and/or the horse/pony is not currently registered with Ponies Association (UK), then they have **14 days** to submit their memberships/registrations in order for the qualification to remain valid
- ◆ Qualifications will be verified by the show secretary when the results are sent into the Ponies Association (UK) office
- ◆ Once owner, rider/handler, horse/pony are registered **entries must be made** on the official Ponies Association (UK) Winter National Championship Entry Form. These can be obtained from the Ponies Association (UK) website or by sending an A5 SAE with large letter stamp to the Ponies Association (UK) office.  
**All entries must be sent into the Ponies Association (UK) office before the closing date for entries**

## ***SUMMER NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS***

- ◆ **1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>** placed horses/ponies **in each** Ponies Association (UK) Summer National Championship Qualifying class will qualify. Qualification will pass **no lower than 3<sup>rd</sup> place**

# **WORDING FOR THE** **2010 P(UK) SUMMER NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS**

## **Qualification for Summer National Championships**

**1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placed horses/ponies in all Summer National Championships will qualify for the 2010 P(UK) Summer National Championships.**

Results must be submitted to the Ponies (UK) office within 14 days of the qualifying show with the exception of shows being held between 1<sup>st</sup> July and 31<sup>st</sup> July; these shows need to submit their results within 48 hours after the qualifying event.

Qualification cards will not be presented in the ring.

Competitors in qualifying positions, who are **not** current members of P(UK) are allowed **14 days** in which to become members and register their horses/ponies in order for the qualification to remain valid. The exception being any competitor qualifying at a show between 1<sup>st</sup> July and 31<sup>st</sup> July their membership must be submitted within 48 hours after the qualifying event in order for the qualification to remain valid.

### **S01 P(UK) GLYN GREENWOOD M&M IN-HAND SUMMER CHAMPIONSHIP**

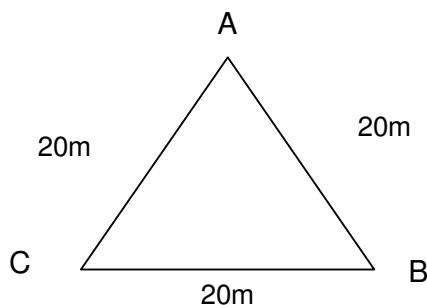

**Minimum height of fences 61 cms (2') and maximum height of fences 92 cms (3')**

**This class may be split at the discretion of the affiliated show.**

These classes are designed to encourage the horse/pony and rider to perform stylishly.

#### **Method of Judging:**

# **AFFILIATED SHOWS GUIDELINES FOR SHOW SECRETARIES**

**A copy of the final schedule stating Judges appointed must be forwarded 2 months before the date of the event**

Affiliation will **NOT** be accepted until:

- a) The Affiliation form and fee has been received, after which an affiliation number will be allocated.
- b) A draft schedule, which **must** include the Judge's names, together with a copy of the current Public Liability Policy must be sent to P(UK).
- c) The Final Schedule **MUST NOT** be printed or issued until the draft has been approved and all amendments requested by P(UK) have been incorporated into the Final Schedule.
- d) Affiliations will be withdrawn if qualifying events fail to send in an approved final schedule and valid insurance certificate at least eight weeks prior to the event

**A CHANGE OF SHOW SECRETARY MUST BE NOTIFIED TO THE P(UK) OFFICE IMMEDIATELY in order that the Website can be updated.**

**SHOWS WITH WEBSITES – PLEASE ENSURE YOU SUPPLY US WITH YOUR UP TO DATE WEBSITE ADDRESS IN ORDER FOR US TO PROVIDE A LINK FOR COMPETITORS TO VISIT YOUR SHOWS WEBSITE AND DOWNLOAD SCHEDULES ETC AS REQUIRED TO PROMOTE YOUR EVENT**

## **JUDGES TRAVELLING FEES / EXPENSES**

Shows are expected to pay Judges reasonable travelling fees or any other expenses, we advise a maximum amount to be agreed **prior** to the event, preferable in writing. If Officials are expected to work on a voluntary basis this should be agreed prior to the date of the show.

## **RIDE JUDGES**

Shows affiliated to P(UK) - who are not affiliated to an individual Governing Body - may select to omit the Ride Judge from any Horse classes providing an R-Con Judge is used. Should a Ride Judge fall or be thrown whilst judging under P(UK) rules they may not continue to ride the exhibits or carry out any further ride judging on that day. If the Judge is capable of continuing his / her duties then **all** exhibits in the class must give an individual show (including any exhibit previously ridden). In the event that the Judge is not capable of continuing, an appropriately qualified replacement may be appointed otherwise the class must be abandoned. Should a replacement Judge be appointed or the class abandoned a full report must be submitted in writing to P(UK) within 7 days of the incident.

ALL Ride Judges officiating under Ponies Association (UK) rules **MUST** wear a hat to the approved current BSI standard at all times whilst mounted.
